- Please note: There will be a homebased option for faith formation instruction with monthly parent support and ongoing opportunities for service during the year.
- The first Family Mass at 9:30 a.m. will occur on Sunday, 9/25/22, and continue the 2nd and 4th Sundays (10/09, 10,23, 11/13, 11/27, etc.)
